Join homeschoolers all across the country and the world in prayer. We've put together the following series of ten prayer topics that you can cover as you pray.

## **1 Give thanks for the freedom we have to homeschool our children.**

"You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up." - Deut. 6:7

## **2 Pray for homeschooling families in your own nation and around the world.**

"Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart." - Jeremiah 29:12-13

## **3 Pray for upcoming elections and the impact they may have on homeschool freedom.**

"Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence." - 1 Timothy 2:1-2

## **4 Pray for your elected officials to recognize that education of children is the responsibility of parents.**

"Behold, children are a heritage from the Lord, the fruit of the womb is a reward." - Psalm 127:3

## **5 Pray your family's homeschool journey would be fruitful.**

"For I will look on you favorably and make you fruitful, multiply you and confirm My covenant with you." - Leviticus 26:9

"that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God" - Colossians 1:10

## **6 Pray for the Lord's guidance for your homeschool journey and for healthy relationships.**

"For You are my rock and my fortress; therefore, for Your name's sake, lead me and guide me." - Psalm 31:3

## **7 Pray for your children and their future. Ask God to help you as you nurture the gifts in each one.**

"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope." - Jeremiah 29:11

## **8 Ask the Lord for wisdom as you raise your children to love and follow Him.**

"For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth comes knowledge and understanding; He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly" - Proverbs 2:6-7

## **9 Pray for opportunities to encourage and minister to others.**

"And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work." - 2 Corinthians 9:8

## **10 Rejoice in God's mercy and faithfulness in all things.**
